MODIFICATION OF ORDER  
OF REINSTATEMENT

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Pharmacy upon receipt of a letter dated April 26, 2012 from legal counsel for Nitin Khandwala (Respondent) requesting that the Board modify the Order filed on November 13, 2002 in the matter of Nitin Khandwala, R.P. Among other things, pursuant to the November 13, 2002 Order, Respondent was barred from dealing with any program administered in whole or in part by the Division of Medical Assistance and Health Services.

The Board having reviewed and agreed to Respondent's request to modify the 2002 Order to clarify that the bar was based upon Respondent's 1999 Disqualification as a provider for the New Jersey Medical Assistance and Health Services Program (Medicaid) and other Federally or State funded health insurance programs for a minimum period of 8 years, the parties having agreed to the resolution of this matter without further formal proceedings, and the Respondent having agreed and

given his voluntary consent to the within order and waiving any right to a hearing in this matter, and the Board finding the within disposition adequately protective of the public's health, safety, and welfare, and other good cause having been shown;

IT IS THEREFORE on this <sup>th</sup> 11 day of OCTOBER, 2012,

ORDERED:

1. All the terms of the Consent Order filed on November 13, 2002 are incorporated as if fully set forth herein and remain in effect, except that Ordered paragraph 2(b) is hereby revised as follows: Respondent shall be barred from dealing with any program administered in whole or in part by the Division of Medical Assistance and Health Services, including but not limited to any dispensing, consulting, billing activity or management of a pharmacy *until such time as the Division of Medical Assistance and Health Services reinstates the provider participation of the Respondent.*
