



Esq., appeared before a Committee of the Board regarding his request to reinstate his license. Mr. Bonaventure testified and provided proof of his compliance with the August 31, 2011 Consent Order, including proof he completed his period of incarceration, payment of all penalties and fines, a copy of his Avenel evaluation, and a copy of a psychological evaluation by a Board approved psychologist stating that Mr. Bonaventure can safely practice accounting and is not a threat to the public. After additional information was requested, received and reviewed by the Board, the Board has determined that Mr. Bonaventure is fit and competent to practice public accountancy in the State of New Jersey and voted to reinstate Respondent's license subject to the conditions listed below.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS on this 24<sup>th</sup> day of DECEMBER, 2012,

**ORDERED AND AGREED,**

1. Michael Bonaventure's license to practice accountancy in the State of New Jersey is hereby reinstated upon the filing date of this order.
2. Michael Bonaventure shall provide a copy of this consent order within ten (10) business days of the filing date of this order, to his New Jersey State Parole Board officer, and provide proof of such submission to the Board.
3. Michael Bonaventure shall be responsible to ensure that his Board-approved psychologist shall supply a report every ninety (90) days beginning on the "filed" date of this Order to the Board confirming he continues to engage in psychotherapy at a minimum of once a week.

4. Michael Bonaventure shall continue to engage in psychotherapy with a pre-approved Board psychologist once a week for a minimum of three years from the filing date of the Order. There shall be no reductions or discontinuance of psychotherapy until such time that Mr. Bonaventure submits documentation to the Board from his Board approved psychologist recommending such reduction or discontinuance and thereafter receives Board approval.


5. Michael Bonaventure shall report any alleged violation of his Parole Supervision for Life requirements to the Board office in writing within forty-eight (48) hours of any alleged violation.

6. Michael Bonaventure hereby consents to the entry of an Order of automatic suspension of licensure without notice, upon the Board's receipt of any information which the Board in its sole discretion deems reliable that Mr. Bonaventure has violated and/or failed to comply with any of the conditions set forth by the New Jersey State Parole Board.

7. Mr. Bonaventure shall have the right to apply for removal of the automatic suspension on five (5) days notice but in such event shall be limited to a showing that he in fact did not violate and/or fail to comply with his parole conditions, or that other information submitted to the Board was false.
