INTERIM CONSENT ORDER

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners (hereinafter, the "Board") on December 6, 2012 by the Attorney General of New Jersey, Wendy Leggett Faulk, Deputy Attorney General appearing, upon the filing of a Motion to Enforce Litigant's Rights ("Motion"), with a return date of December 12, 2012. The Motion seeks the immediate suspension of the medical license of Rodolfo D. Narag, M.D. ("Respondent"), for his violation of a 2005 Board Order restricting his medical practice to the performance of Independent Medical Examinations (IMEs) on behalf of third parties

and with regard to patients demonstrating musculoskeletal symptomology.

Respondent seeks an adjournment of the return date of the Motion until January 9, 2013, and further agrees to cease his practice of medicine until the matter is heard.

The Board, finding the within Order to be adequately protective of the public health, safety and welfare, and for other good cause shown;

IT IS, therefore on this 12 day of December, 2012;


ORDERED that:

1. Respondent, Rodolfo D. Narag, M.D., agrees to cease and desist from the active practice of medicine in all jurisdictions effective the 12th day of **December, 2012**, and until such time as the Board makes a determination on the Motion to Enforce Litigant's Rights. The hearing on the Motion currently scheduled for December 12, 2012 is hereby adjourned until January 9, 2013.
2. Respondent shall file any opposition to the Motion on or before close of business Thursday, December 20, 2012; said response to be delivered to the Board with a copy delivered on that same date and time to Wendy Leggett Faulk, Deputy Attorney General.
3. This Interim Consent Order does not constitute an admission by or finding against Respondent.
4. The parties hereto stipulate that entry of this Order shall not limit the authority of the Attorney General of New Jersey or any other person or agency, including this Board, to initiate any


further action permitted by law, whether administrative, civil or criminal, in any court or other forum of competent jurisdiction in connection with any matters relating to Respondent's conduct.


