WHEREAS this matter was previously heard before a Hearing Committee of the State Board of Nursing on February 20, 2013, and,

WHEREAS following said hearing, the Hearing Committee entered an Order, attached hereto, pursuant to which the certification of Providence Green, CHHA to practice as a homemaker home-health aide in the State of New Jersey, was temporarily suspended, effective February 20, 2013, and

WHEREAS it had been specifically provided, both in the Order to Show Cause entered on February 6, 2013 and within the Hearing Committee's Order, filed on February 25, 2013 (effective February 20, 2013) that the Hearing Committee's Order was to be

subject to review by the full Board of Nursing, which review was to occur on the record established as of February 20, 2013, and

WHEREAS the full Board of Nursing met on March 1, 2013, and then reviewed the record established in this matter, to include pleadings, evidence and a transcript of the hearing held on February 20, 2013, and

WHEREAS the Board unanimously concludes that the established record in this matter fully supports the findings made and actions taken by the Hearing Committee, and further concludes that good cause exists to adopt, in its entirety and without modification, the Order entered by the Hearing Committee,

IT IS on this 13th day of March, 2013

ORDERED:

The Board hereby adopts, in its entirety and without modification, the Order entered by the Board Hearing Committee (attached hereto and incorporated herein in full). The temporary suspension of respondent Providence Green's certification to practice as a homemaker home-health aide in the State of New Jersey, which had been ordered by the Hearing Committee effective February 20, 2013, shall continue in full force and effect pending final adjudication of the allegations

of the Verified Complaint including Board review of the results of any plenary hearing at the Office of the Administrative Law.
