

TO PRACTICE PHYSICAL THERAPY :
IN THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY :

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Physical Therapy Examiners (hereinafter "the Board") upon the application for reinstatement of her license to practice physical therapy of Maureen Nash (Nee Porter), P.T. (hereinafter "Respondent"), who, having voluntarily surrendered her license to practice physical therapy indefinitely on April 23, 2012, has now appeared before the Board for an investigative inquiry on January 22, 2013, and has testified in support of her application for reinstatement.

Having reviewed the entire record, including the testimony of Respondent at the investigative inquiry, it appears to the Board that Respondent has demonstrated her fitness to practice physical therapy with certain conditions; has presented evidence that her medical

condition has sufficiently resolved, such that she is able to safely practice physical therapy with certain conditions; has satisfactorily completed her criminal probation; and has offered satisfactory proof of her rehabilitation and control of her substance abuse issues.

It Now Appearing that the parties wish to resolve this matter without recourse to formal proceedings; that Respondent seeks leave to return to practice in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Order; that Respondent hereby waives any right to a further hearing on this application; and that the Board finds the within Order adequately protective of the public's health, safety and welfare; and for good cause shown;

IT IS on this 1st day of April, 2013

ORDERED AND AGREED that:

1. Respondent shall complete thirty (30) hours of continuing education approved by the Board prior to again engaging in the practice of physical therapy, and shall provide documentation thereof to the Board.

2. Upon her demonstrated satisfaction of paragraph 1 hereof, Respondent's license shall be reinstated with the following conditions:

a) that prior to engaging in the practice of physical therapy, Respondent has obtained an assessment of her use of chemical substances and/or her chemical dependency by the Professional Assistance Program of New Jersey ("PAPNJ") or another similar program pre-approved by the Board, and that Respondent agrees to abide by the recommendations of the PAPNJ or other approved program, which shall be set forth in a report to the Board of its assessment. The PAPNJ or other approved program shall report to the Board quarterly thereafter, for a minimum of one year. Respondent agrees to the release of said reports to the Board. Respondent waives her right of confidentiality in the assessment and reports for that purpose, and for use of the reports in any license proceeding. Respondent shall be solely

responsible for the payment of all costs associated with the aforesaid assessment and monitoring performed by PAPNJ or other approved program. Respondent agrees that the PAPNJ or other approved program shall report any indication of a "slip" or relapse to the Board immediately.

b) that Respondent shall engage in the practice of physical therapy for no more than twenty (20) hours in any one (1) week during the first six (6) months of her return to practice;

c) that Respondent shall practice only in a practice which simultaneously employs another licensed physical therapist in good standing, until further Order of the Board; and

d) that Respondent shall not practice physical therapy in a home care, sub-acute, or hospital setting, until further Order of the Board.
