This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Nursing (" Board") upon receipt of respondent's request for reinstatement of her nursing license. Respondent's license was suspended pursuant to a Final Order of Discipline filed on

February 12, 2013, when she failed to fully respond to a Board inquiry concerning an arrest on or about June 30, 2012 on charges of aggravated assault with a weapon. A \$200.00 civil penalty was also imposed by the February 12, 2013 Order.

Respondent has now fully responded to the Board's original inquiry, has demonstrated that the criminal charges have at present not yet been adjudicated, and has provided payment of the civil penalty imposed by the Board. Respondent has provided documentation indicating that the June 30, 2012 arrest resulted from a dispute between respondent and her boyfriend, wherein her boyfriend claims that he was intoxicated and injured himself when respondent tried to remove from his possession a steak knife he was brandishing.

The Board finding that pursuant to the terms of the February 12, 2013 Final Order of Discipline, reinstatement of respondent's nursing license is appropriate, as respondent has complied with the specified conditions of reinstatement, and for other good cause shown;

IT IS on this 22nd day of April, 2013

HEREBY ORDERED AND AGREED that:

1. Respondent's petition for reinstatement of her license to practice nursing in New Jersey is granted.
2. Respondent shall advise the Board in writing when the charges against her have been adjudicated, and shall forward

documentation of the disposition to the attention of George Hebert, R.N. Executive Director, Board of Nursing, P.O. Box 45010, Newark, NJ 07101 within ten days of disposition.

3. Nothing herein shall preclude the Board from taking action on the underlying conduct that was originally the subject of inquiry in this matter, after the charges have been adjudicated.
