PHARMACY PURSUANT TO  
N.J.A.C. 13:39-4.19

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This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Pharmacy ("Board") upon receipt of information that Ameridose, LLC, a pharmacy located at 201 Flanders Road in Westborough, Massachusetts (NJ Registration 28RO00037600) and Ameridose, LLC, a pharmacy located at 205 Flanders Road in Westborough, Massachusetts (NJ Registration 28RO00034300) voluntarily agreed

to recall any unexpired products on October 31, 2012 and voluntarily agreed to temporarily cease and desist operation as a pharmacy in the State of Massachusetts.

The parties, having agreed to resolution of this matter without further formal proceedings, and Ameridose, LLC, having agreed and given voluntary consent to the within order and waiving any right to a hearing, and the Board finding the within disposition adequately protective of the public health, safety, and welfare, and other good cause having been shown;

**IT IS THEREFORE** on this 25<sup>th</sup> day of APRIL, 2013,

**ORDERED AND AGREED that**

1. Ameridose, LLC28RO00037600 and Ameridose, LLC 28RO00034300 shall immediately cease and desist shipping, mailing, distributing or delivering in any manner, legend drugs or devices or controlled substances pursuant to a prescription into the State of New Jersey; and shall cease and desist participation in any and all central prescription handling arrangements involving New Jersey facilities.

2. Ameridose, LLC 28RO00037600 and Ameridose, LLC 28RO00034300 shall not commence any operation as out-of-state pharmacies pursuant to N.J.A.C. 13:39-4.20(d) until they hold an active, unrestricted license to operate in the State of Massachusetts.

3. This Agreement is not and shall not be construed to be a disciplinary action or sanction of any kind, nor as an admission of liability or wrongdoing by any of the Registrants including their officers, directors, managers, and employees, nor as an admission of ineligibility for licensure pursuant to N.J.A.C. 13:39-4.20.

4. The entry of the within Order is without prejudice to the further investigation and/or prosecution of any violations by respondent of any statutes or regulations governing the practice of pharmacy in the State or any violations of law, by the Board, the Attorney General or any other regulatory or law enforcement agency, including but not limited to any pending matters under investigation.
