

HOMEMAKER HOME HEALTH AIDE :
IN THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY :

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Nursing ("Board") upon receipt of information indicating that Vernice L. Henderson, C.H.H.A. ("Respondent") whose certification expired on November 11, 2007, altered her expired CHHA certificate to appear as though it was a New Jersey Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) license and also altered the expiration date to make it appear current (2013). In addition, it was reported that Respondent also previously altered her CHHA certificate to indicate an expiration date of 2011.

The Board finds that Respondent has engaged in acts constituting crimes which relate adversely to the practice of nursing in violation of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21 (f) and has engaged in the use of or employment of

dishonesty, fraud, deception, misrepresentation, false promise or false pretense in violation of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21 (b) as well as engaged in professional or occupational misconduct as determined by the board pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21 (e).

The parties having agreed to the resolution of this matter without further formal proceedings, and Respondent having agreed and given her voluntary consent to the within Order and waiving any right to a hearing in this matter; and the Board finding the within disposition adequately protective of the public health, safety and welfare, and other good cause having been shown;

IT IS on this 26th day of April, 2013,

ORDERED that:


1. Respondent's certification to practice as a homemaker-home health aide in the State of New Jersey is hereby revoked with prejudice. Respondent shall not hereafter apply for reinstatement of her certification.

2. Respondent shall immediately cease and desist from holding herself out as a certified homemaker-home health aide and/or practicing as a homemaker-home health aide, which includes but is not limited to performing delegated nursing regimens or nursing tasks delegated through the authority of a duly licensed professional nurse.


3. Respondent shall immediately cease and desist from holding herself out as a Licensed Practical Nurse and/or practicing as a Licensed Practical Nurse.

4. Respondent shall surrender her most recent certificate to practice as a homemaker-home health aide by mailing same together with this signed Order to the Deputy Attorney General identified above.
