This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Nursing (the "Board") upon receipt of a written petition from John A. Schemmer, Jr., RN, ("Respondent") to be released from all of the restrictions and conditions placed upon his practice of nursing pursuant to the terms agreed to in a Final Consent Order filed on May 8, 2006.

The Consent Order provided that Respondent could maintain his license and continue to practice nursing with several restrictions, and with the condition that he was to enroll in

and comply with the terms of the Recovery and Monitoring Program

("RAMP").

The terms of the Consent Order permitted Respondent to apply to the Board in writing for the lifting of the requirements and restrictions of that Order upon successful completion of the RAMP. Respondent has submitted proof of successful completion of such program, and requested that the restrictions placed on his nursing license be lifted. Moreover, RAMP notified the Board that Respondent had successfully completed his RAMP five year contract.

The Board has determined that Respondent has complied with the terms of the original Consent Order, including successful completion of RAMP. The Board has, therefore, determined that the within Order is sufficiently protective of the public health, safety and welfare; and in lieu of further proceedings, and for other good cause shown;

IT IS on this 15th day of May, 2013

HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Respondent's petition to be released from all conditions and restrictions contained in the original Final Consent Order filed on May 8, 2006 is hereby granted and Respondent's license is no longer subject to restriction or

encumbrance.
