**Re: Letter to Initial Applicant Who Disclosed A Disqualifying Conviction and Qualified after Board Review, With a Two (2) Year Period of Probation**

Dear Mr. Mack:

The records of the New Jersey State Board of Nursing ("Board") reveal that you have submitted an application for certification as a homemaker-home health aide. In connection with that application a Criminal History Record Background Check (C.H.R.B.C.) was conducted pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:11-24.4. The Board has received a report concerning the C.H.R.B.C. which confirmed a record of a disqualifying conviction which you disclosed on your application. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:11-24.3b, the Board has reviewed the information you submitted as evidence of rehabilitation and finds the evidence to be clear and convincing.

The application has now been fully processed and you are deemed qualified. **Please note the Board has placed you on probation for two (2) years. If you are arrested and/or convicted during this time, all such arrests and convictions MUST be reported to the Board within five (5), business days.** Your certification will be mailed directly to your address of record within 14 business days. Upon your receipt of this letter, you are eligible to work as a homemaker-home health aide. **YOU SHOULD KEEP THIS LETTER AS PROOF OF YOUR ELIGIBILITY.** If you have any questions, please call Twalema Khonje, Paralegal, in the Homemaker-Home Health Aide Department of the Board of Nursing at (973) 504-6546.
