This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Nursing (the "Board") upon receipt of information indicating that Jennie Noelle Drexler, ("Respondent"), a Registered Professional Nurse, has requested to withdraw from the Recovery and Monitoring Program (RAMP) and has offered to voluntarily surrender her license to practice in New Jersey. Respondent had allowed her New Jersey nursing license to lapse in 2008 as she was working in New York, where she also held a nursing license. In 2010, Respondent was arrested twice - once on a drug-related charge and once on a charge of driving while intoxicated. On

August 30, 2011, the Board filed an Order of Reinstatement of License, agreed to and signed by Respondent and her attorney. The Order of Reinstatement required Respondent to undergo a comprehensive mental health and substance abuse evaluation under the auspices of RAMP and to follow the recommendations of RAMP for further treatment. Respondent's participation with RAMP was intermittently non-compliant, followed by re-enrollment, and finally, a request to withdraw from RAMP and surrender her New Jersey nursing license because Respondent was not working in New Jersey and had no plans to do so.

The parties desiring to resolve this matter, Respondent waiving any right to a hearing, it appearing that there is good cause for entry of this Order, and Respondent and the Board agreeing to its entry;

IT IS on this 1 day of July, 2013

HEREBY ORDERED AND AGREED that:

1. Respondent hereby voluntarily surrenders her license to practice nursing in the State of New Jersey. Respondent shall not hereafter apply for reinstatement of her license unless and until she appears before the Board or a committee, if requested, and can demonstrate that she is fit and competent to practice nursing, and that RAMP supports her return to practice.

2. Respondent shall immediately cease and desist practice

as a Registered Professional Nurse in the State of New Jersey and shall not represent herself as a Registered Professional Nurse unless and until her license is reinstated by further Order of the Board. Any practice in this State prior to reinstatement shall constitute grounds for a charge of unlicensed practice.
