This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Nursing ("Board") upon receipt of Sharond Y. Magby's application for licensure by endorsement as a Licensed Practical Nurse dated on or around April 2, 2012. On her application, Ms. Magby indicated that there was a pending investigation concerning her professional license by a professional board in another state. Upon further inquiry, the New Jersey Board obtained a copy of a Consent Order approved and accepted by the Alabama Board of

Nursing on September 21, 2012. The Alabama Board of Nursing concluded that Ms. Magby had engaged in unprofessional conduct and ordered her license suspended until she paid a \$300 fine, completed courses on end-of-life care and documentation, and notified her employer about the Consent Order. Ms. Magby complied with the terms of the Order and her Alabama license was removed from suspension on or about February 12, 2013.

The Board finds that the conduct described in the Alabama Consent Order constitutes professional misconduct as determined by the New Jersey Board of Nursing. Ms. Magby has had her authority to engage in nursing suspended by the Alabama Board of Nursing for conduct which would give rise to discipline in New Jersey pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(g).

The Board having reviewed this matter, and having considered the nature and timing of the above conduct, and the parties desiring to resolve this matter, and the Board having determined that the within Order is sufficiently protective of the public, in lieu of further proceedings, and for other good cause shown;

IT IS on this 16th day of July, 2013

HEREBY ORDERED AND AGREED that:

1. Sharond Y. Magby's application for licensure by endorsement is hereby granted.

2. Sharond Y. Magby is hereby reprimanded for having her license suspended in a sister state for conduct which would give rise to discipline in New Jersey pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(g).
