**This matter** was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Physical Therapy Examiners (hereinafter "the Board") upon receipt of information which the Board has reviewed, and the parties wishing to resolve this matter without further formal proceedings, hereby stipulate to the following findings of facts and conclusion of law:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent, Aleksandr Kharkover, P.T., is a physical therapist in the State of New Jersey and has been a licensee at all times relevant hereto.
2. On May 10, 2013, in the United States District Court, Eastern District of New York, Respondent pleaded guilty to, and was convicted of, five counts of Health Care Fraud in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1347, and was sentenced to twenty-four (24) months in prison, to be followed by three (3) years of supervised release. In addition, Respondent was ordered to make restitution

in the amount of \$4,665,137.66; and to forfeit assets in the form of real or personal property derived directly or indirectly from gross proceeds traceable to his offenses, and/or as substitute assets. Respondent was required to pay \$680,000.00 on or before his sentencing, as an initial payment toward the Forfeiture Money Judgment entered against him.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

Respondent's conviction provides grounds for the surrender, to be deemed a revocation, of his license to practice physical therapy in New Jersey, pursuant to N.J.S.A 45:1-21(f), in that Respondent has been convicted of a crime involving moral turpitude and relating adversely to the practice of physical therapy.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS on this 6 day of August, 2013

ORDERED AND AGREED that:

1. Respondent's license to practice physical therapy shall be surrendered with prejudice, to be deemed a revocation; and Respondent shall not apply for reinstatement or practice physical therapy in the State of New Jersey.

2. Respondent shall return his original New Jersey license to the office of the Board no later than August 15, 2013.
