This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Nursing (the "Board") upon receipt of information indicating that Joshua O'Neill, ("Respondent"), a Registered Professional Nurse, had become non-compliant with his agreement with the Board's designated intervention program, the Recovery and Monitoring Program of the Institute for Nursing (RAMP), and faced suspension of his license. In lieu thereof, Respondent offered to voluntarily surrender his license to practice in New Jersey. Respondent no longer works in the field of healthcare

and has no intent to return to the practice of nursing.

The parties desiring to resolve this matter, Respondent waiving any right to a hearing, it appearing that there is good cause for entry of this Order, and Respondent and the Board agreeing to its entry;

IT IS on this 8th day of Aug., 2013
HEREBY ORDERED AND AGREED that:

1. Respondent hereby voluntarily surrenders his license to practice nursing in the State of New Jersey to be deemed a revocation with prejudice. Respondent shall not hereafter apply for reinstatement of his license.

2. Respondent shall immediately cease and desist practice as a Registered Professional Nurse in the State of New Jersey and shall not represent himself as a Registered Professional Nurse. Any practice in this State shall constitute grounds for a charge of unlicensed practice.
