This matter was most recently opened to the State Board of Pharmacy upon receipt of information that Alan Kay, R.P. had applied for an unrestricted license to practice pharmacy. On September 2, 2008, respondent was arrested and charged with unlawful possession of controlled dangerous substances (CDS) and prescription legend drugs. On February 6, 2009, respondent was granted a twelve-month conditional discharge by the municipal court, and was required to complete all terms and conditions of the Conditional Discharge Program. Respondent voluntarily surrendered his license to practice pharmacy by way of a Consent Order filed with the Board on December 9, 2009. By Consent Order filed with the Board December 2010, respondent was granted a pathway to reinstate his license. In December 2011 Mr. Kay

completed all prerequisites and his license was reinstated subject to a minimum two year probationary period during which he was prohibited from acting as a preceptor or a pharmacist-in-charge (RPIC) at any pharmacy and prohibited from owning or having an ownership interest in any pharmacy. He was also required to participate in the Professional Assistance Program during the period of probation.

In support of his application for unrestricted licensure, Mr. Kay provided documentation to the Board showing full compliance with the 2010 Consent Order. The Professional Assistance Program submitted a letter indicating that all monitoring has been successful and Mr. Kay is now over four years in ongoing recovery.

The Board having determined that Mr. Kay has complied fully with the 2010 Consent Order and the Board having determined that the within Order is adequately protective of the public health, safety, and welfare,
