RE: Letter of Qualification to Initial Applicant Who Did Not Disclose a Disqualifying Conviction and Has Since Obtained An Order of Expungement

Dear Ms. Burns:

The records of the New Jersey State Board of Nursing ("Board") reveal that your referenced application for certification as a homemaker-home health aide should be reconsidered.

In preparation for this initial application, a Criminal History Record Background Check ("CHRBC") was conducted pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:11-24.4 which revealed certain "disqualifying" criminal activity pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:11-24.3(a). However, your sworn statement authorizing the CHRBC indicated that you had not been convicted of any "disqualifying" crime or offense.

As a result of our Provisional Letter of Disqualification dated *March 5, 2013*, providing you thirty (30) days to submit a written "**Petition Disputing the Accuracy of the CHRBC**", you filed a petition to the Superior Court to have your disqualifying conviction expunged, and your petition was granted.

The Board has reviewed this matter and you will be deemed qualified to work as a Homemaker-Home Health Aide, after the receipt of a \$100.00 fine. The fine should be paid by certified check or money order, payable to the Board at the address above.
