

ORDER OF SURRENDER  
OF LICENSE

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of  
("Board") upon receipt of information that respondent was unable  
to respond to a Board inquiry which had been forwarded to her

because she was being treated for a serious medical condition. Board had also been advised that respondent wished to surrender nursing license. The Board being satisfied that respondent is presently unable to perform the functions of a licensee for or other reasons within the intendment of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(i), for other good cause shown;

HEREBY ORDERED AND AGREED THAT:

1. Respondent shall hereby voluntarily surrender her L.P.N. nursing license and she shall refrain from the further practice of nursing pending further order of the Board. Respondent shall forward her nursing license, along with her wallet-sized biennial renewal license forthwith to Susan Carboni, Deputy Attorney General, P.O. Box 45029, 124 Halsey Street, 5<sup>th</sup> Floor, Newark, NJ 07101 on behalf of the Board of Nursing.

2. The Board shall not entertain any application for reinstatement from respondent unless and until respondent can demonstrate that she is fit and competent to resume nursing and is able to fully respond to allegations that while she was at Bayada Home Health Care, she presented unauthorized blanks signed by a physician to excuse herself from work. The reserves the right at such time to complete its inquiry into this

matter, and to impose discipline if appropriate.
