THIS MATTER was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Architects ("Board") upon receipt of information that on or about April 23, 2013, the New York Board of Regents adopted the provisions set forth in an "Application for Consent Order" ("New York Order") executed by the Respondent, Robert M. Scarano, Jr., RA, at which time his New York license to practice architecture was suspended for twenty-four (24) months, with the last eighteen (18)

months stayed, and he was placed on probation for twenty-four (24) months with certain terms and conditions.

Specifically, Respondent admitted guilt to one specification of professional misconduct, charging him with unprofessional conduct (willful failure to comply with substantial provisions of the laws of the City of New York governing the practice of the profession of architecture) as more fully set forth in the New York Order, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

As a result of the foregoing, the Board has determined that the New York disciplinary action provides a basis to take disciplinary action against Respondent's New Jersey license to practice architecture pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(g).

IT NOW APPEARING that the parties wish to resolve this matter without recourse to formal proceedings; and that the Respondent hereby waives any right to a hearing in this matter; and the Board finding the within Order adequately protects the public's health, safety and welfare; and for good cause shown;

IT IS ON THIS 10 day of October, 2013, **ORDERED AND AGREED AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Respondent's license to practice architecture in the State of New Jersey shall be, and hereby is, suspended for a period of two (2) years, effective the date of the filing of this Consent Order, the initial one (1) month to be served as a period of active suspension and the remainder to be stayed and served as a period of

probation. Said probationary period shall not terminate until Respondent demonstrates to the Board's satisfaction that his probationary period in New York has successfully terminated and that he holds an active unrestricted license to practice architecture in New York.

2. Respondent agrees that if the Board, upon receipt of reliable information and in its sole discretion, determines during the probationary period that the Respondent has failed to comply with any provision of the New York Order, or is in violation of any of this Board's statutes and/or regulations, then the period of stayed suspension provided above shall be activated and Respondent's New Jersey license to practice architecture shall be automatically and immediately suspended without a hearing, in addition to any other limitations or restrictions as the Board deems appropriate. Within five (5) days of notification of the suspension, Respondent may provide a written request for a hearing limited to the sole issue of whether a violation of this Consent Order has occurred.


