This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of  
Massage and Bodywork Therapy (" Board") upon the receipt of  
information indicating the following;

1. Respondent is a licensed massage and bodywork therapist  
whose license expired on November 30, 2012.

2. Respondent was arrested on January 24, 2011 and charged with prostitution; she was convicted for the use of offensive language on January 24, 2011. A total of \$405.00 in fine/assessments were imposed. (Exhibit A)

3. On or about March 22, 2013, respondent was asked in a writing sent to her address of record by certified and regular mail, to submit the transcripts of her court appearance to the Board. The certified mailing of the written request was signed for. (Exhibit B) The regular mailing was not returned. No response has been received to date.

3. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 4:1-7.1(b), any license which has not been renewed within 30 days of its expiration date is suspended without a hearing.

ACCORDINGLY,

IT IS on this 4<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2013

HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Respondent's license to practice massage and bodywork therapy in the State of New Jersey has been suspended pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-7.1(b).

2. Upon any application for reinstatement of license, respondent shall respond in full to the request on behalf of the Board to provide the transcripts of her court appearance on

January 24, 2011.

3. The Board reserves the right to bring disciplinary action in connection with respondent's conviction, if warranted.
