

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Pharmacy (the "Board") upon receipt and review of the following information:

1. Brian A. Jackson ("Respondent"), Registration No. 28RW01141800, was initially registered to practice as a pharmacy technician in this State on September 10, 2009.
2. The Board received a criminal flagging notice indicating that respondent, who had an expired registration, was arrested on June 2, 2011, and charged with possession of marijuana. Mr. Jackson responded to the Board's request for information with a short explanation.

3. Respondent did not renew his registration to practice as a pharmacy technician prior to its expiration on August 31, 2010, and has not renewed or attempted to renew his registration since that time.

4. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-7.1(b), any pharmacy technician registration which has not been renewed within thirty (30) days of its expiration date is suspended without a hearing.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS on this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of October, 2013,

ORDERED THAT:

1. Respondent's registration to practice as a pharmacy technician in the State of New Jersey shall be, and hereby is, suspended by operation of N.J.S.A. 45:1-7.1(b), without a hearing. Any practice as a pharmacy technician during the period in which respondent does not hold an active registration shall be deemed unregistered practice and shall subject him to disciplinary action.

2. In the event that respondent seeks reinstatement of his New Jersey registration, he shall appear before the Board or a committee of the Board to establish that he is fit to practice as a pharmacy technician in this State.

3. The Board reserves the right to deny reinstatement, take disciplinary action and place restrictions and/or limitations upon respondent's registration to practice as a pharmacy technician in the State of New Jersey.
