This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Dentistry ("the Board") upon the filing of an Administrative Complaint on August 14, 2013 against Respondent, Hipolito Solano, for the unlicensed practice of dentistry. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-18.2, the Board is authorized to investigate and prosecute any person who engages in the unlicensed practice of medicine. The Complaint was served on August 28, 2013. Respondent never filed an Answer to the Complaint.

On October 8, 2013, a Notice of Motion for Default and Default Judgment was filed with a return date of November 6, 2013. The Notice of Motion for Default and Default Judgment was served on October 10, 2013.

On November 6, 2013, Respondent did appear before the Board of Dentistry. In order to avoid a hearing on the unlicensed practice of dentistry in this case, Respondent consents and agrees to each and every term of this Consent Order. The Board has determined that the within disposition is adequate to protect the public health, safety and welfare at this time. For such reasons and other good cause shown,

IT IS ON THIS 6th DAY OF November, 2013,

HEREBY ORDERED AND AGREED THAT:

1. Respondent shall cease and desist from practicing dentistry until further Order of the Board.

2. Respondent is assessed an aggregate civil penalty of \$5,000 for the unauthorized practice of dentistry. The Board will stay the entire amount of the penalty for a period of five (5) years. If during that five (5) year period, Respondent is found to have engaged in the unlicensed practice of dentistry, the total amount of the penalty will be due immediately. If, at the end of the five year period, Respondent has not violated this agreement or any law or regulation administered by the Board, the \$5,000 civil penalty assessed by this agreement will be vacated.

3. Respondent is assessed \$2,500 in attorney fees. Payment of the costs shall be made in twenty five (25) monthly installments of \$100 by certified check or money order. Payment is to be forwarded to the attention of Jonathan Eisenmenger,

4. The parties hereby stipulate that entry of this Order is without prejudice to further action, by this Board or any other Professional Board of New Jersey, including the Board of Nursing, the Attorney General, the Drug Control Unit, the Director of the Division of Consumer Affairs or other law enforcement entities resulting from Respondent's conduct prior to the entry of this Order.

5. Respondent has been specifically informed of his right to retain an attorney to represent him in this matter. Respondent acknowledges that he has been advised of his right to counsel, has waived that right and voluntarily enters into this Consent Order.
