This matter was opened to the Board of Massage and Bodywork Therapy ("the Board") upon receipt of the application of Alex Cange for licensure as a massage and bodywork therapist. Upon a review of the application and the criminal history background check, it was ascertained by the Board that the applicant had been arrested on May 21, 2013 in connection with allegations

that in the course of his employment as a cashier (with no connection to massage and bodywork), he offered unauthorized discounts to friends who purchased items where he worked. The charges were ultimately dismissed. Mr. Cange has acknowledged offering the unauthorized discounts for certain articles and indicates that he has learned from his experience.

The Board finds that the conduct admitted to by the applicant was deceptive within the intendment of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(b). The Board has concerns because the conduct was recent.

The Board further finds that granting the applicant's request for licensure is appropriate under the circumstances, in light of the fact that Mr. Cange has never previously been arrested, his remorse and relative youth, as he is twenty-two years old. Finding that the within order is sufficiently protective of the public health, safety and welfare, and for other good cause shown;

IT IS ON THIS 15<sup>th</sup> DAY OF November, 2013

HEREBY ORDERED AND AGREED THAT:

1. Mr. Cange's application for licensure shall be granted upon his demonstration that he has satisfied licensure requirements and paid all applicable fees, if he has not already done so. Mr. Cange shall be placed on probation for a period of

two years, dating from the filing of this Order. The conditions of probation are set forth below.

3. Mr. Cange shall report to the Board within five (5) business days any arrest, indictment or conviction for any crime or disorderly persons offense.

4. Mr. Cange shall obey all the laws of the State of New Jersey, the United States and their political subdivisions as well as all regulations, rules or laws pertaining to the practice of massage and bodywork therapy in the State or jurisdiction in which he practices massage and bodywork therapy.

5. Any deviation from the terms of this Order without the prior written consent of the Board shall constitute a failure to comply with the terms of this Order. Upon receipt of any reliable information indicating that the applicant has violated any term of this Order, Mr. Cange's license may be automatically suspended by the Board. Mr. Cange, upon notice, may request a hearing to contest the entry of such an order. At any such hearing, the sole issue shall be whether any of the information received regarding Mr. Cange was materially false.

6. At the end of the term of probation, Mr. Cange may petition the Board in writing for release from the terms of this Order. In the event that there have been no arrests or convictions during the period of probation, the Board may then grant such a

petition by means of a written communication, without need for further Order of the Board.
