

Administrative Action
PROVISIONAL ORDER
OF DISCIPLINE

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Examiners of Master Plumbers ("the Board") upon receipt of information which the Board has reviewed and on which the following preliminary findings of fact and conclusions of law are made:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Vincent J. Dabundo ("respondent") is a licensed master plumber in the State of New Jersey, having received his license on December 1, 1970, and has been a licensee at all times relevant hereto. Respondent is currently registered with the Board to trade as "Vincent Dabundo Plumbing and Heating." (Exhibit A, certification from Acting Executive Director Rosemarie S. Baccile, attached).

2. The Board received a complaint from consumer S.B. dated December 15, 2011. The complaint pertained to plumbing work respondent was contracted to perform on or about May 17, 2007. S.B. alleges he and respondent entered into a contract for the completion of plumbing work and heating on S.B.'s property. Respondent quoted a price of \$26,000.00, \$15,000.00 of which was to be a down payment, with \$6,000.00 to be paid

after inspection and \$5,000.00 to be paid upon completion. The job was scheduled to be completed within sixty (60) days. A permit was obtained to begin the work. (Exhibit B, copy of complaint from consumer S.B., attached). (Exhibit C, copy of contract, attached).

3. According to S.B., respondent received payment in the amount of \$15,500.00, but never returned to perform any of the work. S.B. alleges he contacted respondent to inquire when the work would be completed and respondent stated that the contract was good for four (4) years. (Exhibit B, copy of complaint from consumer S.B., attached).

4. On or about October 30, 2010, S.B. and respondent entered into an amended agreement. The amended agreement stated the project would be completed in thirty (30) days. If the project was not completed within that scheduled period, S.B. would be entitled to damages. (Exhibit D, copy of amended agreement, attached).

5. S.B., through his attorney, Edward Thompson, Esq., sent respondent a letter dated August 25, 2011. The letter stated that despite receiving payment from S.B., the project has not been completed and respondent is therefore in default of the contract and addendum. The letter gave respondent further opportunity to complete the project by September 9, 2011, otherwise S.B. would take legal action. (Exhibit E, copy of letter sent by Edward Thompson, Esq. to respondent dated August 25, 2011, attached).

6. The Board sent a letter to respondent, dated January 3, 2012, requesting he provide a response to S.B.'s complaint. Respondent provided the requested response in a letter to the Board dated January 24, 2012. Respondent stated the project with S.B. had been on going for four and a half (4.5) years because three (3) years had passed between the time the proposal was presented and the time the contracts were signed and the permits were issued. Respondent stated the project could have been finished in four (4) weeks. Respondent also stated that the permit had been taken out by S.B. and there was a dispute over stolen materials which resulted in S.B. breaking the contract and hiring a different plumber. (Exhibit F, copy of response to complaint from respondent, attached).

7. S.B. filed a complaint against respondent in the Superior Court of New Jersey, Special Civil Part, under docket number ATL-DC-010462-11. S.B. obtained a judgment in the amount of \$12,341.00 against respondent for breach of contract and failure to pull permits after a trial on April 17, 2012. (Exhibit G, copy of letter from Edward Thompson, Esq., dated April 23, 2012, attached). (Exhibit H, Order of Judgment, Atlantic County Superior Court, Special Civil Part, attached).

8. Respondent has failed to satisfy the judgment and has verbally informed the Board that he has no intention of paying the judgment that was entered against him. (Exhibit A, certification from Acting Executive Director Rosemarie S. Baccile, attached).

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The above preliminary findings of fact provisionally provide grounds for disciplinary action against respondent's license, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(e), in that respondent has engaged in professional misconduct by not paying the valid \$12,341.00 judgment obtained against him by consumer S.B. Additionally, the above preliminary findings of fact provisionally provide grounds for disciplinary action against respondent's license, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(e), in that respondent has engaged in professional misconduct by failing to complete the work he contracted to perform for S.B.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS on this *21* day of *November*, 2013,

PROVISIONALLY ORDERED that:

1. Respondent is hereby provisionally reprimanded, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-22, for the violations of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(e) as described above.

2. Respondent's license to practice plumbing in the State of New Jersey is hereby provisionally suspended for violating N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(e), by not paying the valid \$12,341.00 judgment obtained against respondent by consumer S.B. Prior to the Board granting any request by respondent for reinstatement of his plumbing license, respondent shall be required to appear before the Board and provide documentation, demonstrating

to the Board's satisfaction, that he has satisfied the judgment obtained against him by consumer S.B.

3. Respondent shall provisionally pay a civil penalty in the amount of two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00), pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-22, in that respondent engaged in professional misconduct, in violation of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(e), by failing to complete the work he was contractually obligated to perform for consumer S.B. Payment of the civil penalty totaling \$2,500.00 shall be submitted simultaneous with the entry of any final order in this matter, by certified check or money order, made payable to the State of New Jersey, and shall be sent to, Rosemarie S. Baccile, Acting Executive Director, Board of Examiners of Master Plumbers, 124 Halsey Street, Sixth Floor, Newark, New Jersey 07101.

4. Respondent shall cease and desist from the violations described herein. Subsequent violations will subject respondent to enhanced penalties pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-25.

5. Failure to timely remit any and all civil penalties required by this order will result in the filing of a certificate of debt with interest accruing at the rate provided by the Rules of Court, and such failure, or any violation of this order, may result in subsequent disciplinary proceedings for failure to comply with an Order of the Board, which could include the suspension or revocation of license.

6. The within Order shall be subject to finalization by the Board at 5:00 p.m. on the 30th business day following entry hereof unless respondent requests a modification or dismissal of the above stated Findings of Fact or Conclusions of Law by:

a) Submitting a written request for modification or dismissal to Rosemarie S. Baccile, Acting Executive Director, Board of Examiners of Master Plumbers, P.O. Box 45029, 124 Halsey Street, Sixth Floor, Newark, New Jersey 07101.

b) Setting forth in writing any and all reasons why said findings and conclusions should be modified or dismissed or arguments in mitigation.

c) Submitting any and all documents or other written evidence supporting respondent's request for consideration and reasons therefore.

7. Any submissions will be reviewed by the Board, and the Board will thereafter determine whether further proceedings are necessary. If no material discrepancies are raised through the submission by respondent during the thirty-day period, or if the Board is not persuaded that submitted materials merit further consideration, a Final Order of Discipline will be entered.

8. In the event that respondent's submissions establish a need for further proceedings, including, but not limited to, an evidentiary hearing, respondent shall be notified with regard thereto. In the event that an evidentiary hearing is ordered, the preliminary findings of fact and conclusions of law contained herein shall serve as notice of the factual and legal allegations in such proceeding. Further, in the event a hearing is held and upon review of the record, the Board shall not be limited to the findings, conclusions and sanctions herein.



Please be advised that this office represents the above named customer. I have reviewed the contract of May 17, 2007 and the addendum thereto dated October 30, 2010. Unfortunately, despite the payment to you of over \$10,000 in moneys towards the completion of the project, the project not only has not been completed, but it has barely started. Clearly, you are currently in default of the contract and addendum. Unfortunately, your actions are also in violation of the New Jersey Consumer Fraud law and can subject you to financial penalties as well as the suspension of your license.

This letter is to provide you a final opportunity to complete your requirements under the contract to avoid a law suit and contact with the state licensing authorities. Mr. Bhowmik has graciously given you until September 9, 2011 to complete the project. If the project is not completed by that date, Mr. Bhowmik intends to move forward with his law suit and claims against you. Since that would not be in your financial interest, I would urge you to take immediate steps to complete the project. You may contact Mr. Bhowmik directly in order to make those arrangements.

The project itself required about 4 weeks of labor, but was spread out over many months due to the scheduling of the owner.**
3. Any travel time charges? **The project was 50 miles from my office. The commuting time was built into the labor charges.**
4. Describe any novelty and/or skill required to perform this job. **This job required the understanding of plumbing skills and principles.**
5. If a permit was required for this job, you must forward a copy of the permit and inspection report. **The permit was taken out by the owner. Since there was a dispute over material stolen from the building, the owner broke the contract and hired another plumber. The final inspection report would be in the possession of the other plumber or the owner, if the project was completed.**
