

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Nursing (" Board") upon receipt of respondent's request for reinstatement of her nursing license. Respondent's nursing

license had been suspended pursuant to a Final Order of Discipline filed on November 19, 2013. The basis for the suspension was respondent's failure to fully respond to a Board inquiry about an arrest that had been dismissed, and her failure to demonstrate completion of continuing education requirements for the 2009-2011 biennial renewal period and the 2011-2013 renewal period. A reprimand was also imposed for respondent's failure to provide accurate information on her renewal application about continuing education.

Respondent has paid a total of \$450.00 in civil penalties for her failure to cooperate with a Board investigation in violation of N.J.A.C. 13:45C-1.2, and her failure to timely complete continuing education in violation of N.J.A.C. 13:37-5.3. Moreover respondent has satisfied the terms of reinstatement set forth in the November 19, 2013 Final Order of Discipline, in that she has documented completion of all required continuing education for the 2009-2011 and 2011-2013 renewal periods. Respondent has also provided a more complete response to the Board's original inquiry.

The Board finding that respondent has complied with all the requirements for reinstatement set forth in the Final Order of Discipline, and that there is good cause for the entry of this order, in lieu of further proceedings and for other good cause shown;

IT IS, on this 6th day of January, 2014

HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Respondent's petition for reinstatement of her New Jersey nursing license is hereby granted.
