This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners ("Board") upon receipt of information regarding the medical practice and conduct of Dante Greco, M.D. On the basis of that information, the Board opened an inquiry.

Dr. Greco now seeks leave to voluntarily permanently retire from the practice of medicine in New Jersey, after a long and distinguished medical career serving his patients, to fully resolve all outstanding inquiries, and the Board finding that the within

disposition to be adequately protective of the public health, safety, and welfare, and other good cause having been shown,

IT IS ON THIS 27 day of January, 2014

ORDERED THAT:

1. Dante Greco, M.D. is hereby granted leave to and shall immediately surrender his license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey, with such surrender to be deemed a permanent retirement.

2. Dr. Greco shall immediately return his current biennial registration to the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners, P.O. Box 183, Trenton, New Jersey 08625-0183.

3. Dr. Greco shall immediately return his current CDS registration to the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners, P.O. Box 183, Trenton, New Jersey 08625-0183.

4. Dr. Greco shall immediately advise the Drug Enforcement Administration of this Order and provide proof of such notice to the Board.

5. Dr. Greco shall immediately cease and desist from practicing medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey.

6. Dr. Greco shall comply with the "Directives Applicable to Any Medical Board Licensee who is Disciplined or Whose Surrender of Licensure has been Accepted", which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.


7. Dr. Greco agrees to not reapply for a New Jersey medical license or to seek a CDS registration in New Jersey in the future.

8. Dr. Greco shall comply with the guidelines set forth in N.J.A.C. 13:35-6.5(h) in closing his practice.





**NOTICE OF REPORTING PRACTICES OF BOARD
REGARDING DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS**

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-3(3), all orders of the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners are available for public inspection. Should any inquiry be made concerning the status of a licensee, the inquirer will be informed of the existence of the order and a copy will be provided if requested. All evidentiary hearings, proceedings on motions or other applications which are conducted as public hearings and the record, including the transcript and documents marked in evidence, are available for public inspection, upon request.

Pursuant to 45 CFR Subtitle A 60.8, the Board is obligated to report to the National Practitioners Data Bank any action relating to a physician which is based on reasons relating to professional competence or professional conduct:

- (1) Which revokes or suspends (or otherwise restricts) a license,
- (2) Which censures, reprimands or places on probation,
- (3) Under which a license is surrendered.

Pursuant to 45 CFR Section 61.7, the Board is obligated to report to the Healthcare Integrity and Protection (HIP) Data Bank, any formal or official actions, such as revocation or suspension of a license (and the length of any such suspension), reprimand, censure or probation or any other loss of license or the right to apply for, or renew, a license of the provider, supplier, or practitioner, whether by operation of law, voluntary surrender, non-renewability, or otherwise, or any other negative action or finding by such Federal or State agency that is publicly available information.

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:9-19.13, if the Board refuses to issue, suspends, revokes or otherwise places conditions on a license or permit, it is obligated to notify each licensed health care facility and health maintenance organization with which a licensee is affiliated and every other board licensee in this state with whom he or she is directly associated in private medical practice.

In accordance with an agreement with the Federation of State Medical Boards of the United States, a list of all disciplinary orders are provided to that organization on a monthly basis.

Within the month following entry of an order, a summary of the order will appear on the public agenda for the next monthly Board meeting and is forwarded to those members of the public requesting a copy. In addition, the same summary will appear in the minutes of that Board meeting, which are also made available to those requesting a copy.

Within the month following entry of an order, a summary of the order will appear in a Monthly Disciplinary Action Listing which is made available to those members of the public requesting a copy.

On a periodic basis the Board disseminates to its licensees a newsletter which includes a brief description of all of the orders entered by the Board.

From time to time, the Press Office of the Division of Consumer Affairs may issue releases including the summaries of the content of public orders.

Nothing herein is intended in any way to limit the Board, the Division or the Attorney General from disclosing any public document.
