**CONSENT ORDER OF
TEMPORARY SUSPENSION
OF NJ CDS REGISTRATION**

14-006

This matter was opened to Eric T. Kanefsky, Director of the New Jersey Division of Consumer Affairs (the "Director") on or about January 14, 2014, upon information that Jennifer Lamphier, D.M.D., License No. 22DI02074100, NJ CDS Registration No. D07653400 ("Respondent") was obtaining Controlled Dangerous Substances ("CDS") by fraud, specifically that Respondent was filling prescriptions for CDS prescriptions in a patient's name but retrieving them for her own use in violation of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(m) et. seq.

A joint investigation was conducted by the Lake Hopatcong Police Department, Roxbury Township Police Department, and the Division of Consumer Affairs, Enforcement Bureau. The investigation included multiple visits to local pharmacies, patient interviews, and a February 11, 2014 interview of Dr. Lamphier.

On February 11, 2014, Respondent was interviewed by the Roxbury Township Police Department. During the interview, Respondent admitted that she was self-medicating with CDS. She further admitted that she would obtain CDS, in part, by calling in the CDS prescription under a patient's name and then retrieving it herself.

Respondent, who maintains a dental practice at Eastern Dental, with a number of practice locations in the state, having been advised that she may consult legal counsel before signing this interim order, but has expressed her consent to the temporary suspension of her NJ CDS Registration pending the outcome of criminal proceedings and/ or further order of the Director.

The Director, finding the within disposition adequately protective of the public health, safety and welfare, and other good cause having been shown,

IT IS, therefore, on this 11th day of February, 2014,

ORDERED THAT:

1. Respondent's New Jersey CDS registration No. 22DI02074100 is temporarily suspended pending further order of the Director.
2. Respondent shall immediately return her original New Jersey CDS registration to Eric Kanefsky, Director, New Jersey Division of Consumer Affairs, Attention: Matthew Wetzel, Acting Executive Director Drug Control Unit, P.O. Box 45005, 124 Halsey Street, Newark, New Jersey, 07101, and shall immediately cease and desist from prescribing or dispensing any CDS medications.
3. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 24:21-12(f), the Director shall promptly notify the DEA of the entry of this Interim Consent Order.
4. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 24:21-12(e) the Director further orders that Respondent immediately place under seal all prescription pads and any and all CDS in her possession, except

for any CDS Respondent possesses for personal use pursuant to a duly issued prescription. Respondent's prescription pads and CDS shall remain under seal until such time as a final order which includes the disposition of these sealed items is entered by the Director in this matter.

5. Respondent understands that this Interim Order is independent of, and not in lieu of, criminal proceedings and further agrees that resolution of the pending criminal charges will not resolve any matter which has, or could, be brought before the Board or Director. The parties hereby stipulate that entry of this Order is without prejudice to the filing of an Administrative Complaint and/or further investigation and/or action by this Board, Director or other law enforcement entities resulting from Respondent's conduct. The parties further stipulate that the entry of this Order is without admission of any wrongdoing by Respondent.

6. This order shall remain in effect until specifically modified by the Director through the entry of a subsequent order(s).

7. Respondent may apply to the Director to request a hearing for modification of the terms of this order. If Respondent requests a hearing to modify this Interim Order, Director shall convene a hearing within forty-five (45) days of Respondent's request to determine whether the restraints in the Interim Order should continue under the requirements set forth in N.J.S.A. 24:21-12.

8. Respondent has been specifically informed that she may consult an attorney to represent her in this matter. Respondent acknowledges that she has been advised of the ability to consult with counsel and that she chooses to voluntarily enter into this Interim Consent Order.




