ORDER OF THE BOARD

TO OPERATE AS A PHARMACY
IN THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY

This matter was initially heard by a committee of the New Jersey State Board of Pharmacy (hereinafter the "Board") on December 17, 2013, before members Edward McGinley, R.P. and Margherita Cardello, R.P. The Committee entered an interim order denying the Attorney General's request for a temporary suspension of the pharmacy permit of Jacobs Pharmacy (hereinafter the "Pharmacy"), but placing certain conditions on the reopening of the Pharmacy because it determined that there was a serious and significant risk of imminent danger to the public health, safety and welfare, if the Pharmacy were allowed to reopen without satisfying certain conditions to ameliorate that risk. The Interim Order entered by the Committee was effective upon oral announcement of the Committee's decision on December 17, 2013, and embodied in a written order entered January 21, 2014, appended to this Order and adopted here in its entirety. The Interim Order and Report of the Committee, together with the record from the hearing, was presented to the full Board at its meeting on January 29, 2014.

The full Board has reviewed the Order of the Committee and the record of the hearing. The Board unanimously votes to ratify and adopt, in its entirety, the Order of the Committee. The Board finds the reasoning of the Committee, outlined at length in the Committee's order, convincingly supports the Committee's conclusion, and now this Board's conclusion, that the instability created by a third party in this matter has created a serious and significant risk of imminent danger to the public health, safety and welfare, warranting the imposition of certain conditions that must be met prior to allowing the Pharmacy to reopen.

IT IS THEREFORE on this 26th day of February, 2014,

ORDERED:

1. The Board adopts, in its entirety, the Interim Order and Report of the Hearing Committee to the Board filed on January 21, 2014, attached hereto and made a part hereof.
2. Jacobs Pharmacy shall not be permitted to reopen until it satisfies all requirements as set forth in the Committee's Order.
