

This matter was first opened to the State Board of Pharmacy (the "Board") upon receipt of information that Michael Jaffe, R.Ph., had applied for an unrestricted license to practice pharmacy. On April 9, 2010 Mr. Jaffe entered into a Consent Order in which his license to practice pharmacy was suspended for three years, the entire period to be stayed and served as a period of probation. The suspension was based on information that Mr. Jaffe, while employed at Walmart Pharmacy 10-5047 in Audobon, New Jersey, wrote prescriptions for his spouse without a physician authorization. Upon investigation, Mr. Jaffe admitted that he had dispensed 400 tablets of Alprazolam (Xanax 0.25) and 60 tablets of Alprazolam ER (Xanax 0.5) without

prescriber authorization. As a result of this conduct, Mr. Jaffe was terminated from his employment for gross misconduct. The Consent Order required, among other things, that Mr. Jaffe not act as a preceptor or Pharmacist in Charge (RPIC), nor have any ownership interest in any pharmacy.

Mr. Jaffe has presented the Board with documentation showing compliance with the requirements of the 2010 Order, and currently is seeking to remove all restrictions from his license to practice pharmacy. During the probation period, he has obeyed all of the laws of the state, and all regulations pertaining to the practice of pharmacy.

The Board having determined that the within Order is adequately protective of the public health, safety, and welfare,

1. Michael Jaffe, R.Ph., is hereby granted an unrestricted license to practice pharmacy in the State of New Jersey.
