This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Chiropractic Examiners upon receipt of information which the Board has reviewed and the parties wishing to resolve this matter without further formal proceedings hereby stipulate to the following facts and conclusions of law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent, Jody Serra, D.C., is a chiropractic physician in the State of New Jersey and has been a licensee at all times relevant hereto.

2. On April 25, 2013 Respondent appeared before the Board with his attorney Jeffrey Randolph, Esq. to answer questions regarding his practice.

3. Respondent admitted that he trained and permitted an unlicensed assistant and his office manager to perform electric stimulation. Said conduct is a violation of N.J.A.C. 13:44E-2.7(c)

CONCLUSION OF LAW

1. The aforesaid findings of fact provide grounds for the suspension of Respondent's license to practice chiropractic in New Jersey pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(h) in that Respondent permitted unlicensed individuals to perform electric stimulation in violation of N.J.A.C. 13:44E-2.7(c).

IT IS Therefore, on this 24th DAY OF April, 2013

ORDERED AND AGREED THAT:

1. Respondent's license to practice chiropractic in the state of New Jersey is hereby suspended for a period of one (1) year, effective immediately upon the entry date of this Order, except that it shall be stayed in its entirety and shall be a period of probation. Such stayed period of suspension shall be activated upon a showing of Respondent's non-compliance with any of the terms and conditions set forth herein.

2. A civil penalty in the amount of five thousand dollars (\$5000) shall be assessed against Respondent for his violation of N.J.A.C. 13:44E-2.7(c). Payment shall be made by certified check or money order, payable to "State of New Jersey", delivered or mailed to Lisa

Tadeo, Executive Director, State Board of Chiropractic Examiners, 124 Halsey Street, P.O. Box 45004, Newark, New Jersey 07101. Payment shall be made no later than 15 days after the entry of this consent order. In the event Respondent fails to make a timely payment, a certificate of debt shall be filed in accordance with N.J.S.A. 45:1-24 and the Board may bring such other proceedings as authorized by law including activation of the stayed suspension.

3. The Directives of the Board applicable to any Chiropractic Board licensee who is suspended, revoked or whose surrender of licensure has been accepted are incorporated by reference as though fully set forth herein, whether or not they are attached hereto.

4. Failure to comply with the provisions of this Order may result in subsequent disciplinary proceedings for failure to comply with an Order of the Board.






