

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This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Nursing ("the Board") upon receipt of information that a consent order had been entered on January 13, 2014, signed by respondent and by the Honorable Stuart A. Mikowitz, J.S.C. The order was agreed to as a condition for her admission into the Pretrial Intervention Program (PTI) following charges of having violated

N.J.S.A. 2C:21-4a; N.J.S.A. 2C:28-21; N.J.S.A. 2C:28-31; and N.J.S.A. 2C:20-4a, all of which relate to allegations of falsification in payment records submitted for travel reimbursement. By the terms of the order, respondent's certification as a Forensic Nurse-Certified Sexual Assault (FN-CSA) or Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE) was revoked with prejudice to reinstatement.

Respondent admits no guilt in connection with any of the charges against her. Respondent maintains that she will be entitled to an expungement of the charges at a future date.

The Board finding that implementation of the revocation of respondent's FN-CSA certification is authorized by the terms of the January 13, 2014 order, and that the within order is sufficiently protective of the public health, safety and welfare, and for other good cause shown;

HEREBY ORDERED AND AGREED THAT:

1. Marnie Lynn Sperling's certification as a FN-CSA is hereby revoked. Respondent shall not hereafter apply for reinstatement as a FN-CSA.
2. This action by the Board resolves this matter in its entirety with respect to the Board of Nursing.
3. Respondent shall, within three months of the entry of this order, document completion of a continuing education course

in nursing ethics pre-approved by the Board. This ethics course shall not be used towards satisfying the continuing education obligation required pursuant to N.J.A.C. 13:37-5.3.
