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This matter was opened to the Board of Massage and Bodywork Therapy ("the Board") upon receipt of the application of Maria Orden for licensure as a massage and bodywork therapist. Upon a review of the application and the criminal history background check, it was ascertained by the Board that Ms. Orden had been arrested in 2010 and charged with a violation of N.J.S. 2C:12-3B (threaten to kill); and had been charged in January of 2011 with

a violation of N.J.S. 2C:33-4A (harassment). The charges were dismissed. On her application, Ms. Orden had indicated that she had never been charged with any crime or offense. Ms. Orden acknowledged that the information she provided on the application was not correct, although she claimed that the provision of inaccurate information was the result of a miscommunication between Ms. Orden and a person who assisted her in filling out the application.

The Board finds that the applicant knew or should have known that, by indicating "no" on the application in response to the questions about her arrest history, she engaged in misrepresentation on her application in connection with her arrest and conviction history in violation of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(b).

The Board finding that granting the applicant's request for licensure is appropriate under the circumstances, and for other good cause shown;


HEREBY ORDERED AND AGREED THAT:

1. A civil penalty in the amount of \$100.00 is hereby imposed for the applicant's violation of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(b). Payment shall be in the form of a certified check or money order, made

payable to the State of New Jersey, and shall be forwarded simultaneously with this signed Order.

2. The applicant's application for licensure shall be granted upon payment of the above penalty, and upon his demonstration that he has satisfied other licensure requirements, if he has not already done so.


