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This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Nursing upon receipt of information that on or about May 29, 2014, respondent was arrested by the Hudson County Sheriff's

HEREBY ORDERED AND AGREED THAT:

1. Respondent shall hereby voluntarily surrender his nursing license and he shall cease and desist from the further practice of nursing until the criminal charges noted above have been adjudicated and pending further order of the Board.

Respondent shall immediately forward his nursing license, along with his wallet-sized biennial renewal license forthwith to Susan Carboni, Deputy Attorney General, P.O. Box 45029, 124 Halsey Street, Fifth Floor, Newark, NJ 07101 on behalf of the Board of Nursing, simultaneously with this signed order.

2. If respondent is incapable of forwarding his license, along with his wallet-sized biennial renewal license, due to his being in the custody of law enforcement officials, he shall so

notify the Board and then forward his licenses as soon as practicable.

3. This order is entered without any admission of any wrongdoing by Respondent, without prejudice to respondent's ability to defend against the charges currently pending, and/or to any further investigation or prosecution of any matter by the Board of Nursing and the Attorney General or other law enforcement entities against respondent.
