The Alcohol and Drug Counselor Committee of the New Jersey State Board of Marriage and Family Therapy Examiners ("Committee"), has reviewed the request of Calvin Davis ("respondent") for an unrestricted certification to practice alcohol and drug counseling. Respondent was granted a restricted license to practice alcohol and drug counseling by consent order dated September 22, 2006. That order was entered following Mr. Davis' appearance before the Committee on August 25, 2006, during which Mr. Davis testified about his conviction for counterfeiting, successful alcohol and


drug rehabilitation and career as an alcohol and drug counselor.

The Committee has reviewed Mr. Davis application for an unrestricted license, which included a letter from his supervisor, and proof of successful completion of parole, and of continuing education courses at Rutgers University. There have been no further criminal proceedings. Upon review of this information, the Committee is satisfied that Mr. Davis' unrestricted license to practice clinical alcohol and drug counseling is consistent with the public health, safety and welfare.

ACCORDINGLY, it is on this 25 day of July, 2014,  
ORDERED THAT:

Calvan Davis shall be granted an unrestricted license to practice clinical alcohol and drug counseling in the State of New Jersey.
