The Alcohol and Drug Counselor Committee of the New Jersey State Board of Marriage and Family Therapy Examiners ("Committee") has reviewed the application of Laura M. Harrison ("Ms. Harrison" or "respondent") to remove restrictions on her clinical alcohol and drug counselor license. By Consent Order filed on May 15, 2009, respondent's license to practice clinical alcohol and drug counseling was suspended for a period of five (5) years for

engaging in professional misconduct and in a dual financial relationship with a client. During the first three (3) years of the suspension, respondent was restricted from practicing as a clinical alcohol and drug counselor, but could practice as a certified alcohol and drug counselor as an employee under the supervision of a Committee approved supervisor. The remainder of the suspension period was stayed and served as a period of probation, her practice limited by the consent order.

Respondent has now demonstrated that she has fulfilled the terms of the May 2009 consent order, including successful completion of a three (3) credit graduate level courses in ethics and boundary issues; payment of the civil penalty; and submission of a statement listing each job she held during the suspension.

Having reviewed the above, the Committee finds that Ms. Harrison has demonstrated that she is fit and competent to practice without restrictions, and that this Order is consistent with the public health, safety and welfare.


Therefore,

HEREBY ORDERED that the restrictions placed on the license of Laura M. Harrison by the May 15, 2009, Consent

Order are removed. Ms. Harrison has an unrestricted license to practice clinical alcohol and drug counseling effective immediately.
