**CONSENT ORDER OF TEMPORARY  
SUSPENSION OF NJ CDS  
REGISTRATION**

This matter was opened to Steve Lee, Director of the New Jersey Division of Consumer Affairs (the "Director") on or about August 13, 2014, upon receipt of information that Respondent Mohammed Kawam Jabakji, M.D., who holds New Jersey CDS Registration No. D06450600, repeatedly prescribed Controlled Dangerous Substances to undercover federal agents without legitimate medical reasons and without performing necessary physical examinations. This alleged conduct violates N.J.S.A. 24:21-12.

Respondent, who practices medicine in Prospect Park, New Jersey, having been advised that he may consult legal counsel

before signing this interim order, does not admit the conduct alleged, but has expressed his consent to the temporary suspension of his New Jersey CDS Registration pending the outcome of criminal proceedings and/or further order of the Director.

The Director finding the within disposition adequately protective of the public health, safety and welfare, and other good cause having been shown,

IT IS, therefore, on this 13<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2014,

ORDERED THAT:

1. The New Jersey CDS registration held by Respondent (no. D06450600) is temporarily suspended effective immediately, pending further order of the Director.

2. Respondent shall immediately return his original New Jersey CDS Registration to Steve Lee, Director, New Jersey Division of Consumer Affairs, Attention: Executive Director, P.O. Box 45005, 124 Halsey Street, Newark, New Jersey, 07101, and shall immediately cease and desist from prescribing CDS.

4. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 24:21-12(f), the Director shall promptly notify the United States Drug Enforcement Administration of the entry of this Interim Consent Order.

5. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 24:21-12(e) the Director further orders that Respondent immediately place under seal all CDS in his possession, except for any CDS Respondent possesses for personal use pursuant to a duly issued prescription. All CDS shall remain

under seal until such time as a final order which includes the disposition of these sealed items is entered by the Director and in this matter.

6. Respondent understands that this Order is independent of, and not in lieu of, criminal proceedings and further agrees that resolution of the pending criminal charges will not resolve any matter which has, or could, be brought before the Director. The parties hereby stipulate that entry of this Order is without prejudice to the filing of an Administrative Complaint and/or further investigation and/or action by the Director or other law enforcement entities resulting from Respondent's conduct. The parties further stipulate that the entry of this Order is without admission of any wrong doing by Respondent.

7. This Order shall remain in effect until specifically modified by the Director through the entry of a subsequent order(s).

8. Respondent may apply to the Director for modification of the terms of this Order. If Respondent requests a hearing to modify this Order, the Director shall convene a hearing within forty-five (45) days of Respondent's request to determine whether the restraints in this Order should continue under the requirements set forth in N.J.S.A. 45:1-22 and/or N.J.S.A. 24:21-12.


9. Respondent has been specifically informed that he may consult an attorney to represent him in this matter. Respondent

acknowledges that he has been advised of the ability to consult with counsel and that he chooses to voluntarily enter into this Interim Consent Order.


