ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION

ORDER AMENDING PROVISIONAL ORDER
OF DISCIPLINE FINALIZED BY
DEFAULT ON APRIL 14, 2014

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Nursing (the "Board") upon the filing of a Provisional Order of Discipline on January 31, 2014, suspending the certification of Khalia A. Johnson to practice as a homemaker-home health aide and imposing a \$200 civil penalty. The basis for the filing of the order was an alleged failure to cooperate with a Board investigation in violation of N.J.A.C. 13:45C-1.2, -1.3, in violation of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(h).

Subsequent to the finalization of the POD, it came to the attention of the Board that as a result of an administrative error, the POD was finalized by default on April 14, 2014 ("FOD"). However, Respondent had responded to the POD by providing a narrative of the circumstances of her arrest. Respondent did not, however, provide any of the other information requested in the letter of inquiry such as a copy of the court complaint and disposition, a copy of the police report, and information about her current employment. Therefore the final order of date is affirmed including the suspension and the \$200.00 penalty imposed for failure to fully respond.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS on this 5th day of September 2014,
ORDERED that:

The Final Order of Discipline is hereby amended to provide that it was not finalized by default. The suspension of Respondent's certification and the \$200.00 penalty for failure to fully respond to a Board inquiry is affirmed.
