ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION
ORDER OF SUMMARY
SUSPENSION

This matter was opened to the New Jersey Board of Nursing (the "Board") upon receipt of information revealing the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Beatrice Atsriku, C.H.H.A., ("Respondent") was certified as a homemaker-home health aide in the State of New Jersey on December 7, 2011. Her certificate expired on November 30, 2013.

2. Respondent's failure to submit her biennial renewal in 2013 has resulted in a lapsed status and the automatic suspension of Respondent's certificate to practice as a Homemaker-Home Health Aide in the State of New Jersey without a hearing pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-7.1(b).

3. Bright Star agency submitted a complaint to the Board regarding allegations that Respondent left her job repeatedly without notifying the agency, provided false reports of her shift, failed to report a change in the client's condition, attempted to dispense medication to the client, failed to report additional monies provided by the client and verbally intimidated the client and the client's

family by threatening to quit if additional monies were not paid to her.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS on this 12th day of September, 2014,


ORDERED that:

1. Respondent's certificate to practice as a certified Homemaker-Home Health Aide in the State of New Jersey is suspended by operation of N.J.S.A. 45:1-7.1(b), without a hearing.

2. In the event that Respondent seeks reinstatement of her certification at any time in the future, then this order shall require Respondent to appear before the Board to establish that she is fit to practice as a certified Homemaker-Home Health Aide in New Jersey and provide information regarding the circumstances of the complaint filed by Brightstar. Additionally, the Board reserves the right to take disciplinary action and place restrictions and/or limitations upon Respondent's certificate to practice as a Homemaker Home Health Aide in the State of New Jersey.
