

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Pharmacy (hereinafter "the Board") upon receipt of information which the Board has reviewed and on which the following preliminary findings of fact and conclusions of law are made:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Tara M. Tomasello ("Respondent") is a registered pharmacy technician in the State of New Jersey and has been registered at all times relevant hereto. She failed to renew her

registration, allowing it to expire effective October 3, 2014. (See L2K printout, attached and made a part hereto as **Exhibit A**).

2. Respondent was arrested on October 17, 2013 by State Police Woodbine for violating N.J.S.A. 2C:35-10A(1) [Possess Controlled Dangerous Substance or Analog]. On April 23, 2014, Upper Township Municipal Court dismissed the charges. (See Flagging Notice dated October 18, 2013 and Flagging Notice Dated April 29, 2014, attached hereto and made a part hereof as **Exhibit B**).

3. Respondent was arrested on October 23, 2013 by the Atlantic County Sheriff's Office and was charged with unlawfully and knowingly or purposely possess with intent to distribute HEROIN, contrary to the provision of N.J.S. 2C:35-5a(1) and 2C:35-5b(13). On January 8, 2014, Respondent was found Guilty of violating 2C:35-5a(1) [Manufacture/Distribute Controlled Dangerous Substance] and was sentenced to 79 Days Jail, 2 Years Probation, 6 Months Suspended Driver's License, and Amount Assessed \$1,210. (See Flagging Notice dated October 24, 2013, Flagging Notice dated January 10, 2014, Flagging Notice dated April 7, 2014, New Jersey Division of Criminal Justice Special Notice of Indictment/Conviction, Superior Court of New Jersey Law Division - Criminal Atlantic County Waiver of

Indictment Accusation, attached hereto and made a part hereof as **Exhibit C**).

4. By letters dated January 27, 2014, February 4, 2014, and May 21, 2014, the Board sent requests for certain information and the submission of documents to Respondent's address of record in Marmora, New Jersey via regular and certified mail with receipt requested. To date, Respondent has failed to respond to the Board's requests. (See Board letters and copies of the Return Receipts, annexed hereto as **Exhibit D**).

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Board provisionally finds that Respondent's unauthorized possession of drugs, including controlled dangerous substances, provides grounds to take disciplinary action against Respondent's registration to practice pharmacy in the State of New Jersey pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21 (f) in that Respondent has engaged in acts constituting a crime or offense of moral turpitude and/or relating adversely to the activity regulated by the Board. Respondent's failure to respond to the Board's letters constitute a violation of N.J.A.C. 13:39C-1.1 et seq. Respondent's failure to provide the Board with a valid address constitutes a violation of N.J.A.C. 13:39-6.10.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS on this 29th day of October, 2014,
ORDERED that:

UPON THE FILING OF A FINAL ORDER IN THE MATTER:

1. Respondent's certification to practice as a pharmacy technician be and hereby is suspended for five (5) years and until further order of the Board.

2. Respondent shall cease and desist from engaging in practice as a pharmacy technician, which includes but is not limited to the following: Respondent shall not retrieve prescription files or patient files; shall not prepare medication labels; shall not engage in data entry for any pharmacy, shall not count, weigh, measure, pour or compound prescription medication or stock prescription legend drugs or controlled substances; shall not fill an automated medication system; shall not accept authorization for a prescription refill or renewal; shall not handle anything requiring a prescription, including devices and medications; Respondent shall not handle prescriptions; and shall not be present within a prescription filling area of a pharmacy.

3. Any practice in this State prior to such reinstatement shall constitute grounds for a charge of unlicensed practice.

4. Respondent shall immediately surrender her original registration to: Executive Director Anthony Rubinaccio, Board of Pharmacy, P.O. Box 45013, Newark, New Jersey 07101.

5. Prior to any restoration, Respondent shall:

A. Appear before the Board or a committee thereof to discuss her readiness to reenter practice as a pharmacy technician. At that time, Respondent shall be prepared to propose her plans for future practice in New Jersey and shall demonstrate evidence of rehabilitation to the Board's satisfaction.

B. Affirmatively establish her fitness, competence and capacity to actively practice as a pharmacy technician.

C. Provide the Board with a full account of her conduct during the intervening period of time from the entry of this Order to her appearance pursuant to this Order.

D. Provide documentation of successful completion of all application requirements including a Criminal History Background check and payment of all reinstatement fees.

E. If Respondent's registration to practice as a pharmacy technician is reinstated, the Board, in its discretion, may impose any conditions or restrictions it deems necessary to protect the public health, safety, and welfare.

6. The within order shall be subject to finalization by the Board at 5:00 p.m. on the 30th day following entry hereof unless Respondent requests a modification or dismissal of the above stated Findings of Fact or Conclusions of Law by:

a) Submitting a written request for modification or dismissal to Anthony Rubinaccio, Executive Director, State Board

of Pharmacy, 124 Halsey Street, P.O. Box 45013, Newark, New Jersey 07101.

b) Setting forth in writing any and all reasons why said findings and conclusions should be modified or dismissed.

c) Submitting any and all documents or other written evidence supporting Respondent's request for consideration and reasons therefor or offered in mitigation of penalty.

7. Any submissions will be reviewed by the Board and the Board will thereafter determine whether further proceedings are necessary. If no material discrepancies are raised through a supplemental submission during the thirty-day period, or if the Board is not persuaded that the submitted materials merit further consideration, a Final Order of Discipline will be entered.

8. In the event that Respondent's submissions establish a need for further proceedings, including, but not limited to an evidentiary hearing, Respondent shall be notified with regard thereto. In the event that an evidentiary hearing is ordered, the preliminary findings of fact and conclusions of law contained herein may serve as notice of the factual and legal allegations in such proceeding. Further, in the event a hearing is held and upon review of the record, the Board shall not be

limited to the findings, conclusions, and sanctions stated herein.

If you have been indicted by the Grand Jury, please enclose a copy of the indictment. If a criminal accusation has been filed, please enclose a copy of Criminal Accusation. If you are on or have completed probation and/or paid fines/costs, please provide proof of same. Keep this office apprized of any major change in status. A legible copy of the Police Report with all supporting statements. (This can be obtained by visiting the police station where you were arrested). The name and address of your current employer, your job title and dates of employment. A narrative statement from you regarding your version of the underlying conduct which gave rise to the underlying crime/offense for which you were arrested.

Failure to respond and provide these items within fifteen (15) days from receipt of this letter hereof will constitute a violation of the afore stated provisions and may result in the filing of a provisional order of discipline for suspension and imposition of monetary penalties.

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
