

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Nursing (hereinafter the "Board") upon receipt of information regarding the alleged conduct of Djaforo L. Annan, C.H.H.A. ("hereinafter "Respondent"). On the basis of this information, the Board opened an inquiry into the matter.

It is alleged that on or about April 28, 2000, Respondent provided inaccurate identifying information to the New Jersey State Police's State Bureau of Identification Division.

It is also alleged that on or about January 28, 2014 and on or about April 18, 2014, Respondent provided inaccurate information to two (2) health care agencies in the course of seeking employment therewith.

Respondent neither admits nor denies the allegations herein. These allegations, if proven, would provide grounds for discipline, including the revocation of Respondent's certification to practice as a homemaker home health aide in the State of New Jersey pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(b) and (e).

Respondent now seeks to voluntarily surrender his certification to practice as a homemaker home health aide in the State of New Jersey with such surrender to be deemed a permanent revocation. Respondent's voluntary surrender to be deemed a permanent revocation will fully resolve all outstanding inquiries, and the Board finding the within disposition to be adequately protective of the health, safety, and welfare of the People of New Jersey, and other good cause having been shown,

**IT IS**, therefore, on this 19<sup>th</sup> day of ~~October~~ <sup>November</sup>, 2014


**ORDERED** that:

1. Respondent is hereby granted leave to immediately surrender his certification to practice as a homemaker home health aide in the State of New Jersey. Such surrender


shall be deemed a permanent revocation of Respondent's certification with prejudice.


2. Respondent shall cease and desist from holding himself out as a certified homemaker home health aide and/or practicing as a homemaker home health aide, which includes but is not limited to performing delegated nursing regimens or nursing tasks delegated through the authority of a duly licensed professional nurse in the State of New Jersey.
3. Respondent shall not reapply for certification as a homemaker home health aide in the State of New Jersey.
4. Respondent shall return his original New Jersey homemaker home health aide wall and wallet certificates as well as any biennial registration cards in his possession by mailing them to Executive Director George Hebert, MA, RN, State Board of Nursing, P.O. Box 45010, Newark, New Jersey 07101 immediately upon entry of the Order.
5. The parties hereby stipulate that entry of this Order is without prejudice to further action or investigation by this Board, the Attorney General, or any other law enforcement entities resulting from Respondent's conduct occurring prior or subsequent to entry of this Order.
