Administrative Action

INTERIM CONSENT ORDER

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners by John J. Hoffman, Acting Attorney General of New Jersey on September 12, 2014, by the filing of a Verified Complaint and Order to Show Cause with the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners (the "Board") seeking the temporary suspension of the license of Gintare Gecys, D.O. ("Respondent") to practice medicine and surgery in New Jersey and other relief. It being alleged in the Verified Complaint that the Respondent's continued practice of medicine represents an imminent danger to the public health, safety and welfare pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-22.

A hearing on the Acting Attorney General's application was scheduled for September 22, 2014. Respondent previously sought an adjournment of the return date of the Order to Show

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Cause until a scheduled date either before the full Board or a Committee in October or November 2014. On September 18, 2014, Respondent entered into an Interim Consent Order whereby she voluntarily agreed to cease and desist from the practice of medicine and surgery effective September 22, 2014.

The parties now seek a further adjournment of the matter until the Board's meeting on January 7, 2015, or any subsequent date agreed to by the parties.

The Board, finding the within disposition to be adequately protective of the public health, safety and welfare, and for good cause shown

IT IS, therefore, on this 24 day of November 2014,

ORDERED that:


1. Respondent is hereby granted leave and shall continue to voluntarily cease and desist from the practice of medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey effective September 22, 2014, pending disposition of the Order to Show Cause, which is adjourned until the Board's meeting on January 7, 2015, or any subsequent date agreed to by the parties. The matter may be heard by either the full Board or a Committee of the Board. The cessation of practice is without any admissions and without any prejudice to any response or defense Respondent may raise to the Acting Attorney General's application;

2. Respondent hereby represents and shall ensure that as of September 22, 2014, and continuing until the disposition of the Order to Show Cause there shall be no medical services offered by her at any location at which she presently engages in the practice of medicine. This limitation shall specifically include the issuance of any prescription for, or dispensation of, medications of any kind, including but not limited to Controlled Dangerous Substances ("CDS");

3. Counsel for Respondent shall file any response to the Order to Show Cause with the Board with a copy to Meaghan Goulding, DAG at least seven (7) business days prior to the rescheduled return date of the Order to Show Cause.


