This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Chiropractic Examiners upon receipt of an application for Reinstatement of Dr. McGuarn's New Jersey Chiropractic license received September 3, 2013.

Respondent appeared before the Board on June 26, 2014 to answer questions regarding an arrest for Criminal Trespass and possession of a firearm for unlawful purpose which charges were subsequently dismissed. He also answered questions regarding

substance abuse issues as well as questions regarding continuing education requirements.

The Board requested documentation that Respondent had received all continuing education credits required for reinstatement as well as documents related to his arrest. These documents established that he was arrested for criminal trespass and possession of a firearm but said charges were subsequently dismissed.

The Board having reviewed this matter at its scheduled meeting on October 23, 2014 and finding that Respondent has satisfied all the continuing education requirements and finding that the within Order is adequately protective of the public health, safety and welfare and that good cause exists for the entry of this Order;

IT IS, on this 5th DAY OF January, 2014

HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Respondent's license to practice chiropractic in the State of New Jersey is hereby reinstated.

2. Respondent shall comply with all applicable requirements for reinstatement of his license pursuant to N.J.A.C. 13:44E-1A.4, including but not limited to the payment of all applicable fees.

3. Respondent shall submit to a full assessment of his progress in recovery from alcohol dependency by the Professional Assistance Program of NJ (PAPNJ).

4. Respondent agrees to abide by the recommendations of the PAPNJ which shall be set forth in a report of its assessment. Respondent agrees to follow the recommendations of the PAPNJ and to the release

of said report to the Board, and waives his right of confidentiality therein for that purpose and of use of the report in any license proceeding.

5. Respondent shall be subject to an order of automatic suspension of his license upon the Board's receipt of any information which the Board, in its sole discretion, deems reliable, demonstrating that Respondent has failed to comply with any of the recommendations of the PAPNJ;


6. Respondent shall have a right to apply for removal of the automatic suspension on ten(10) days notice to the Board and to the Attorney General. The Board may hold a hearing on that application before the full Board or before a committee of the Board. In the event a committee hears the application, its action shall be subject to ratification of the full Board at its next scheduled meeting.

7. The parties hereby stipulate that entry of this Order is without prejudice to further action by this Board or other law enforcement entities resulting from Respondent's conduct.

8. Failure to comply with the provisions of this Order may result in subsequent disciplinary proceedings for failure to comply with an Order of the Board.


