

ORDER TERMINATING  
RESTRICTIONS

TO PRACTICE NURSING IN THE  
STATE OF NEW JERSEY

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This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Nursing ("Board") upon receipt of respondent's petition for relief from the restrictions imposed pursuant to an Order of Reinstatement of License entered on July 1, 2009. Respondent had surrendered her nursing license by means of an Order of Voluntary Surrender filed on July 15, 2008, with the surrender to be deemed a suspension. This surrender followed a finding that respondent was incapable at the time of discharging the functions of a licensee within the intendment of N.J.S.A. 45:1-

21(i). Respondent was subsequently granted reinstatement in 2009 after having undergone treatment and therapy, upon condition that she remain enrolled in the Recovery and Monitoring Program of New Jersey (RAMP), a monitoring program in which she had been participating and which vouched for her substantial recovery efforts.

Respondent was released from RAMP in July of 2013, following successful completion of the requirements of her monitoring agreement.

The Board finding that respondent has been fully compliant with the terms of the 2009 consent order and with RAMP's requirements, and finding that the granting of respondent's petition is warranted and consistent with the public health, welfare and safety, and for other good cause shown;


IT IS, ON THIS 10<sup>th</sup> DAY OF February, 2015

1. The restrictions imposed pursuant to the July 1, 2009 Order of Reinstatement of License are hereby terminated, and respondent's nursing license is no longer subject to restriction or encumbrance.
