This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Nursing ("Board") upon receipt of information which revealed that Jeannine Wiltsey ("Respondent"), a Registered Professional Nurse in the State of New Jersey, was arrested on January 8, 2015 by members of the Gloucester City Police Department and charged with violating N.J.S.A. 2C:24-4(b)(3) (Causing Child to Engage in Sex Act); N.J.S.A. 2C:24-4(b)(4) (Photographs/films Child in Sex Act); N.J.S.A. 2C:24-4(b)(5) (Possess/Distribute Item Depicting

1. The license to practice as a Registered Professional Nurse in the State of New Jersey, issued to Respondent, Jeannine Wiltsey, is hereby voluntarily surrendered, to be deemed a temporary suspension of license, effective immediately, pending disposition of the criminal charges and until further Order of the Board. Respondent shall, contemporaneously with the signing of this Order, forward all nursing licenses, both wallet and wall versions, to Barbara J.K. Lopez, DAG, P.O. Box 45029, Newark, New Jersey 07101, on behalf of the Board of Nursing.

2. Respondent shall immediately cease and desist from holding herself out as a nurse in the State of New Jersey and shall refrain from the practice of nursing in the State of New Jersey pending further Order of the Board.

3. Nothing contained herein shall be deemed an admission of liability on the part of Respondent.

4. The entry of the within Order is without prejudice to the further investigation and/or prosecution of any violations by Respondent of any statutes or regulations governing nursing practice in the State of New Jersey or any other violations of law, by the Board, the Attorney General, or any other regulatory or law enforcement agency, including, but not limited to, any pending matters under investigation.

Sexual Exploitation/Abuse of Child); and N.J.S.A. 2C:24-4(a) (Engaging in Sexual Conduct That Would Impair/Debauch Morals of Child). It is alleged that Respondent took pornographic photographs of a five year old girl which were transmitted over the internet via an email address used by Respondent. Respondent is currently housed in the Camden County Correctional Facility.

The allegations, if proven, would demonstrate that Respondent engaged in acts constituting a crime or offense involving moral turpitude and relating adversely to the practice of nursing pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(f), and lacks good moral character which is an underlying foundation for licensure pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:11-26, both of which would provide bases for disciplinary action against Respondent's license.


It appearing that Respondent agrees to voluntarily enter into an interim agreement temporarily suspending her license without making admissions and without prejudice to her ability to defend any action brought based on the above allegations, and the Board finding the within disposition adequately protective of the public health, safety and welfare; and other good cause having been shown;

IT IS, THEREFORE, ON THIS 26 DAY OF February, 2015,  
ORDERED AND AGREED THAT:


5. Nothing herein shall preclude the Board from initiating further disciplinary action based upon the conduct relating to Respondent as alleged above or upon disposition of the criminal matters. Additionally, the Board reserves the right to impose discipline, limitations, and/or restrictions at the time of Respondent's petition for reinstatement of her license.
