

Administrative Action
ORDER RESCINDING FINAL
OF DISCIPLINE

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Examiners of Master Plumbers ("Board") upon receipt of a request from licensed master plumber Michael J. Guerro ("respondent") to rescind a Final Order of Discipline that was entered on September 18, 2014. The Final Order of Discipline was entered based on respondent's failure to provide a response to the Provisional Order of Discipline entered on June 25, 2014.

In his letter requesting rescission of the Final Order of Discipline, respondent provided documentation of a medical condition which established that he was hospitalized during the thirty day period required by the Provisional Order of Discipline to provide a response. As a result, respondent contends he was unable to provide a response and the Final Order of Discipline was entered by default.

The Final Order of Discipline imposed a reprimand and suspension of respondent's license to practice as a plumbing contractor in the State of New Jersey until such time as he provides copies of the plumbing permits concerning the work he performed for Gary Rush and/or "Superior Heating & Air Conditioning" (unlicensed), as well the final inspections. The Final Order of Discipline also imposes an aggregate civil penalty totaling ten thousand dollars (\$10,000).

On October 23, 2014, the Board considered the information provided by respondent. The Board found that respondent was hospitalized during the pendency of the Provisional Order of Discipline and therefore was unable to provide a response within the required thirty day period

mandated. The Board voted to rescind the Final Order of Discipline entered on September 18, 2014 and to allow respondent thirty (30) days to provide a response to the Provisional Order of Discipline entered on June 25, 2014.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS on this 26 day of FEBRUARY, 2015,
HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The Final Order of Discipline entered by the Board on September 18, 2014 is hereby rescinded.
2. Respondent is hereby provided with an additional copy of the Provisional Order of Discipline entered by the Board on June 25, 2014. The June 25, 2014 Provisional Order of Discipline shall be subject to finalization by the Board at 5:00 p.m. on the 30th business day following entry of this Order of Recision unless respondent requests a modification or dismissal in accordance with the requirements outlined in the Provisional Order of Discipline.
