

ORDER OF SUMMARY
SUSPENSION

TO PRACTICE AS A CERTIFIED :
HOMEMAKER-HOME HEALTH AIDE :
IN THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY :

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Nursing ("Board") upon receipt of information revealing the following:

1. Respondent, April C. Heaney, C.H.H.A., is the holder of Certificate No. 26NH08963700 and was certified to practice as a Homemaker-Home Health Aide in the State of New Jersey on November 1, 2004 and thereafter permitted that certification to lapse on November 30, 2005.

2. The Board is in receipt of information that on May 7, 2014, Respondent was arrested by Lawnside Police for violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:20-11 (Shoplifting) and on November 14, 2014 was found guilty in Lawnside Borough Municipal Court of N.J.S.A. 2C:20-11c(4) (Shoplifting) and sentenced to fifteen days community service and assessed \$455.00; and that on December 10, 2014, Respondent was arrested by Waterford Township Police for violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:36-6 (Possess/Distribute Hypodermic Needle), and 2C:36-2 (Possess Drug Paraphernalia).

3. Respondent's failure to submit her biennial renewal in New Jersey in 2005 has resulted in a lapsed status and the automatic suspension of Respondent's certificate to practice as a Homemaker-Home Health Aide in the State of New Jersey without a hearing pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-7.1(b).

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS on this 6 day of April, 2015,

ORDERED THAT:


1. Respondent's certificate to practice as a certified Homemaker-Home Health Aide in the State of New Jersey is suspended by operation of N.J.S.A. 45:1-7.1, without a hearing.

2. In the event that Respondent seeks reinstatement of her New Jersey certificate at any time in the future, then this Order shall require Respondent to appear before the New Jersey State Board of Nursing to establish that she is fit to practice as a certified Homemaker-Home Health Aide in New Jersey and provide

information regarding the circumstances surrounding the incidents. Additionally, the Board reserves the right to take disciplinary action and place restrictions and/or limitations upon Respondent's certificate to practice as a Homemaker-Home Health Aide in the State of New Jersey.
