

ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT  
OF LICENSE

TO PRACTICE AS A  
LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSE  
IN THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY

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This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Nursing ("Board") upon receipt of respondent's petition for reinstatement of her nursing license. Ms. Miller's license had

been suspended by means of a Final Order of Discipline filed on February 18, 2015. The basis for respondent's suspension was her failure to respond to a Board inquiry concerning an arrest on March 23, 2014, as well as respondent's failure to demonstrate completion of required continuing education for the 2011-2013 licensing cycle, and misrepresentation on respondent's 2013 renewal application with regard to when she would complete required nursing continuing education. A reprimand was imposed for the misrepresentation. Monetary penalties of \$500 (for failure to cooperate with the Board investigation in violation of N.J.A.C. 13:45C-1.2, -1.3) and \$250 (for failure to timely complete continuing education in violation of N.J.A.C. 13:37-5.3) were also imposed.

Respondent has petitioned for reinstatement of her nursing license. She has furnished the information requested by the Board concerning the 2014 arrest (the charges were ultimately dismissed). She has also provided documentation of 30.80 contact hours of continuing education, all of which were attributed to the 2011-2013 licensing cycle, although they were all completed in March of 2015. Respondent has also paid the \$750 in civil penalties imposed by the February 18, 2015 Final Order of Discipline.

The 2015 Final Order of Discipline conditioned respondent's reinstatement upon her providing the information originally

requested by the Board concerning the 2014 arrest, and providing proof of completion of required nursing continuing education for the 2011-2013 licensing cycle.

The Board finding that respondent has satisfied the conditions for reinstatement pursuant to the 2015 Final Order of Discipline, and that reinstatement of respondent's nursing license is therefore appropriate at this time, in lieu of further proceedings, and for other good cause shown;

IT IS, ON THIS 13<sup>th</sup> DAY OF April, 2015

HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Respondent's petition for reinstatement of her license to practice nursing in New Jersey is hereby granted.
