

ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT
OF LICENSE

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Nursing ("Board") upon receipt of respondent's submission of documentation of completion of required nursing continuing education for the 2011-2013 licensing cycle. This submission

satisfies the requirements for reinstatement of respondent's nursing license, which had been suspended by a Final Order of Discipline entered on March 17, 2015, based upon her failing to document completion of thirty (30) contact hours of nursing continuing education attributed to the 2011-2013 licensing cycle. Respondent had provided documentation of only nineteen (19) contact hours. A reprimand was also imposed by the order for respondent's misrepresentation on her 2013 renewal application as to whether she would timely complete her required continuing education. In addition, a total of \$750 in civil penalties was imposed for respondent's initial failure to respond to a Board inquiry, and for failure to timely complete continuing education in violation of N.J.A.C. 13:37-5.3.

Respondent has sent in payment of the \$750 in penalties, and has provided documentation of thirty-one (31) contact hours of continuing education completed on February 12, 2015; and thirty (30) contact hours of continuing education completed on March 22, 2015. Therefore, respondent has remedied her deficiency for the 2011-2013 licensing cycle, and has satisfied her obligation for the 2013-2015 licensing cycle. Respondent will also have a carryover of fifteen (15) contact hours of continuing education which she may apply to her 2015-2017 continuing education obligation, the maximum carryover permissible under the regulation.

The Board finding that respondent has satisfied the conditions set forth in the March 17, 2015 Final Order of Discipline for reinstatement of her nursing license, i.e., demonstrating an additional eleven contact hours of qualifying continuing education to be applied to the obligation for the 2011-2013 licensing cycle, and for other good cause shown;

HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Respondent's petition for reinstatement of her license to practice nursing in New Jersey is hereby granted.
