This matter was opened to the State Board of Pharmacy upon receipt of information that Jeffrey Strougo, R.Ph., had applied for an unrestricted license to practice pharmacy. Mr. Strougo agreed to cease and desist practice following his arrest on charges related to controlled dangerous substances. He was later convicted of one count of Possession of Hydrocodone in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:20-3 and entered into the pre-trial intervention program. By Consent Order filed May 6, 2014, Mr. Strougo's license to practice pharmacy in New Jersey was reinstated and placed on probation through February 13, 2015. During the period of probation, Mr. Strougo was required to enroll in and comply with the Professional Assistance Program and he was prohibited from owning a pharmacy and from acting as a

preceptor or pharmacist-in-charge. He was required to provide a copy of the Order to all employers where a pharmacy license was required for employment or where he had access to medication, prescriptions or patient profiles.

Mr. Strougo is now seeking to remove all restrictions from his license to practice pharmacy and has presented the Board with documentation showing compliance with the requirements of the prior Order.

The Board having determined that the within Order is adequately protective of the public health, safety, and welfare;


