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This matter was opened to the State Board of Pharmacy upon receipt of information that George Yost, R.Ph., had applied for an unrestricted license to practice pharmacy. By Consent Order filed November 4, 2009, Mr. Yost's license to practice pharmacy in New Jersey was reinstated following the expiration of his license in 2007 and his conviction of one count of third degree theft and three counts of third degree possession of CDS. Pursuant to the November 4, 2009 Consent Order, Mr. Yost's license to practice pharmacy was reinstated and placed on probation for a period of two years. During the period of probation, Mr. Yost was prohibited from owning a pharmacy and from acting as a preceptor or pharmacist-in-charge. He was required to provide a copy of the Order to all employers where a

pharmacy license was required for employment or where he had access to medication, prescriptions or patient profiles.

Mr. Yost is now seeking to remove all restrictions from his license to practice pharmacy and has presented the Board with documentation showing compliance with the requirements of the prior Order.

The Board having determined that the within Order is adequately protective of the public health, safety, and welfare;

1. George Yost, R.Ph., is hereby granted an unrestricted license to practice pharmacy in the State of New Jersey.
