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This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Chiropractic Examiners upon receipt of information the Board has reviewed and the parties wishing to resolve this matter without further formal proceedings, hereby stipulate to the following facts and conclusions of law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Howard Zevin, D.C. is a chiropractic physician in the State of New Jersey and has been a licensee at all times relevant hereto.

2. On August 28, 2013, Respondent submitted his most recent on-line application for the renewal of his license.

3. Respondent answered "No" to question #8 on his renewal application which reads: "Since your last renewal have you been arrested, charged or convicted of any crime or offense that you have not already reported to your board/committee? (Minor traffic offenses, such as speeding or parking need not be provided but Motor Vehicle offenses such as driving while impaired or intoxicated must be disclosed.)"

4. Respondent's negative response to question #8 on August 28, 2013 was false and misleading in that he had been arrested on November 18, 2012 and subsequently pled guilty to Disorderly Conduct and was ordered to pay a fine of \$664.00. This was not reported to the Board.

#### CONCLUSION OF LAW

1. The Board finds that Respondent's submission of his application, wherein he answered in the negative to the question whether he had ever been arrested, constitutes the use or employment of dishonesty, deception, or misrepresentation within the intentment of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(b).

ORDERED AND AGREED THAT:

1. A civil penalty in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) is provisionally imposed upon Respondent for his violation of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(b). Payment shall be made by certified check, money order, wire transfer or credit card payable to "State of New Jersey", delivered or mailed to Lisa Tadeo, Executive Director, State Board of Chiropractic Examiners, 124 Halsey Street, Newark, New Jersey 07101. Payment shall be made contemporaneous with the entry of this Consent Order.

2. Failure to comply with the provisions of this Order may result in subsequent disciplinary proceedings for failure to comply with an Order of the Board.
